The West Harbor Preserve became the first park area owned by the Park District of Ottawa County.

The parcel, acquired in 2023 and located in Catawba Island
Township, will be the future site of a kayak launch, walking trails, a parking area, and habitat restoration projects.



Located in Catawba Island Township on a body of water known locally as "the inner harbor," West Harbor Preserve features 12 acres and includes a broad marsh and shoreline.



Islander Woods and Trailhead was acquired in 2024.

Islander Woods and Trailhead is a 7.6-parcel of land in Catawba Island Township containing an undeveloped wooded tract and a scenic pond. Plans call for trails, habitat restoration, a nature play area, and more. A master plan is being drafted for the area, which is currently closed to the public.

MISSION

The mission of the Park District of Ottawa County is to connect, enhance and protect the natural, scenic, environmental and cultural resources of Ottawa County for the enjoyment of residents and visitors.

HISTORY

The Park District of Ottawa County was created by the Ottawa County Probate Court on September 1, 1992.

In 2017, the Ottawa County Board of Commissioners received grant funding from the Ohio
Department of Transportation for the development of an Ottawa County Active Transportation
Plan to plan safe facilities for non-motorized modes of transportation throughout the entire county.

The inception of the Active
Transportation Plan in 2018
spurred the Park District to take
fundamental steps toward its
development.

The Board of Park
Commissioners began meeting
regularly and planning for the
future. During this time the
Board grew from a three-person
to five-person board.

In 2020 the Park District of
Ottawa County passed a countywide levy providing funding to
plan and execute outdoor
recreation projects throughout
Ottawa County.



The annual Bike Safety Camp provides Ottawa County children with valuable lessons in bicycle maintenance and repair, maneuverability, nutrition and exercise.

GRANTS

The annual Parks and Trails
Improvement Grant Program is
open to political subdivisions,

PARKS AND TRAILS

The Portage River Water Trail provides opportunity to enjoy more than 36 miles of shoreline. This state-designated water trail is facilitated by the Park District of Ottawa County and has access points throughout four counties.



Harry Witty Memorial Park in Elmore is one of several locations throughout Ottawa County that provides river access to paddlers.



The North Coast Inland Trail is a 75-mile multi-use trail route. In Ottawa County, the NCIT stretches from the Sandusky County line northwest through Elmore to Genoa.
