Ottawa County Probate Judge reappoints Indorf, Shadoan to county park board

Port Clinton, OH, Dec. 30, 2024 – Judy Indorf and Michael Shadoan were reappointed by Ottawa County Probate Court Judge Frederick C. Hany II to each serve three-year terms on the Park District of Ottawa County Board of Park Commissioners beginning Jan. 1, 2025, through Dec. 31, 2027.

Shadoan, a resident of Oak Harbor, has served as a Park Commissioner since 2018. He holds two degrees from the University of Toledo, a bachelor of science in mechanical engineering, and an associate's degree in design technology. Shadoan is the president/owner of Radiant Windows, Radiant Remodeling, Radiant Investments, Radiant Holdings, and Central Colony Apartments. He has served as the chairman of the Oak Harbor Development Group since 2012. He and his wife, Shawna, have two children.

Indorf, a resident of Danbury Township, has served since 2020 and has called this region home since the age of 3. Indorf has a B.S. in chemical engineering from The Ohio State University and retired in 2019 from the oil refining business after a 40-year career. She serves as the treasurer for the Ottawa County Holiday Bureau Danbury Unit and the chair of the Father Schaefer Endowment at St. Joseph's Church in Marblehead. She and her husband, Larry, a retired teacher and coach at Danbury Schools, have two sons.

Shadoan and Indorf were both reappointed on Dec. 19, 2024. Park Commissioners serve without compensation and oversee the Park District, approving policy, financial and strategic planning

decisions, and work directly with Jannah Wilson, executive director of the Park District of Ottawa County.

“Over the past five years, Michael Shadoan and Judy Indorf have both played integral roles in the development and growth of the Park District,” Wilson said.

The Board of Park Commissioners is comprised of Michael Shadoan of Oak Harbor, Judy Indorf of Danbury Township, Betsy Slotnick of Genoa, Jack Madison of Catawba Island Township, and Trish McCartney of Port Clinton. Park Commissioners hold one to two meetings per month at designated, rotating locations throughout the county. The public is always welcome and encouraged to attend. The next meeting is set for January 14 at 6 p.m. at Bay Township Hall, 4471 W Fremont Rd., Port Clinton 43452.
