- 6. Departmental Reports:
 - a. Friends of The Ottawa Co. Park District (FoOCPD):
 - i. Denny reported that Neil Munger from Wood County Parks has not received anything from WE Realty yet
 - ii. Valerie Winfield resigned from the Friends of Ottawa County X role and Charles Rasko agreed to replace her
 - iii. Discussed ownership of the trail through Genoa Gary is discussing this with the Ottawa County Commissioners and will work to obtain a Memorandum of Agreement through the Prosecutor on ownership
 - iv. Gary talked to the Ottawa County Engineer regarding the opportunity to incorporate a bike lane in the ODOT widening project of Rt 53 between Rt 2 and Rt 163; the County Engineer will contact ODOT to discuss this opportunity
 - v. Denny and Charles Rasko will continue to engage with Lafarge on the Danbury Twp. portion of the trail
 - vi. The Trust for Public Lands is predominantly interested in large projects; their Washington DC office reached out to Dennis to obtain information on the land at the end of Rt 269 which is currently for sale;

 - c. <u>Magsig Farm</u>: next step to contact ODOT; Has LJ Overmeyer sent Mike the sketches/ideas of the barn, existing entrance, parking and new building ideas he indicated he had in his April 23 email? No update

 - e. Portage River Water Trail: the grant for the kayak accessway is on hold
 - f. Portage Plan for Catawba/Portage Trail: No update

- iv. Gary, Linda and I had a telecon with Amy Moore, Executive Director for Erie Metroparks on April 23, 2020; a number of suggestions/ideas were communicated:
 - 1. Role their PAC plays
 - 2. Erie MetroParks partners with the groups that use the parks and often receive funding from them; these groups are permitted to give up to 20% of their annual expenses to a PAC
 - 3. Request other community organizations post their support of our levy on their Facebook pages, e.g. the Rotary
 - 4. Request community members to write letters/articles to the newspapers supporting our levy
 - 5. Census.gov has a demographic website that we may find useful
 - 6. Suggests we connect with Lori Tottman from Knox County as they just passed a first time levy for their parks initiated contact
 - 7. Suggested Beki Hineline who now lives in Oak Harbor would be a great resource. She was the Marketing Manager for Erie Metroparks.
