Donations offered to the Park District shall be approved/accepted as

follows:

Donations shall be defined as donations of money, grant money received by application of the Board, personal property and "in kind" contributions. Designated donations are donations which are designated for a specific purpose. Undesignated donations are donations for which there is no designated purpose or condition.

Donation Value:

\$1 - \$5,000:

Must be approved by Executive Director, logged in receipt book and donation

log sheet

\$5,001.00 +

Must be approved by Probate Judge, logged in receipt book, donation log sheet,

and judgement entry filed

In considering whether to accept a donation, the Director, Board and/or Probate Judge shall determine if the designated purpose, if any, of the donation is in compliance with the Park District mission. The Board of Park Commissioners and the Probate Court Judge may deny the acceptance of any donation which is not in compliance with the Park District mission or which has stipulations or conditions attached that would be difficult to accommodate.

Donations, which are accepted for designated purposes shall be deposited within the corresponding Park District fund. Undesignated donations, which has been accepted, may be placed in any fund as directed by the Director or Park Board.

All accepted donations shall be recognized by the issuance of a Park District of Ottawa County receipt and a letter on Park District stationary thanking the donor.

An annual report of Gifts, Grants, and Donations shall be submitted to the Probate Court by the 31st day of December of each year documenting and acknowledging all donations received within the calendar year.

Donations or gifts of any interest in real estate:

Real estate is defined as property in buildings and/or land, or both.

- (A) Donations or gifts of any interest in real estate shall be submitted to the Probate Court for review and approval. Interest in real estate means the transfer of real estate with or without mineral rights, including oil and natural gas to the Park District of Ottawa County by:
 - (i) Conveyance in fee simple by gift;
 - (ii) Conveyance in fee simple by acquisition;
 - (iii) Granting of easement rights in or over real estate by gift;
 - (iv) Granting of easement rights in or over real estate by acquisition;
 - (v) Leasing and/or renting of real estate.
- (B) The transfer of any interest in real estate may be approved if said transfer is compatible to and in compliance with the Park District mission and plans.
