3. Fiscal Report – Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2022 – Jannah Wilson reviewed the Fiscal Report provided in the board packet. She noted the expenses for the month and replied to a question regarding payments to Croghan Bank noting that these payments represent credit card payments. Jannah also reviewed the 2023 budget worksheets she and Mike Shadoan have completed for submission to the Ottawa County Auditor and to the Ottawa County Commissioners for review. The board discussed the property acquisition line items, noting that unforeseen opportunities may arise. Jannah noted that if throughout the year we find one of our budget line amounts are not adequate, we can allocate additional available funds to that line. During this discussion, the board asked Jason Lewis, Director Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge if he could provide the Park District with a map denoting all of the US Fish and Wildlife properties in Ottawa County. Jason will send a map to Jannah. The board asked how US Fish and Wildlife identifies owners of possible property they may want to purchase. US Fish and Wildlife has a realty group and attorneys that help with this. Jannah noted she plans to contact an attorney suggested by Trust for Public Land to determine how they identify property. Jannah requested the board provide any comments on the budget prior to our next meeting on November 15, 2022

3. Public Comment – Meeting Minutes November 1, 2022 – Tom Bergman, Mayor Village of Genoa, provided an update on the restroom project for which the village received a grant from the Park District. Tom reported that for several reasons the updated cost estimates for Phase 1 and 2 indicate

a significant increase in cost. Tom assured the board that they can complete the Phase 1 work, which is to extend utilities to the restroom location and conduct engineering, with the Park District's grant money supplemented with the funds they have received from ARPA and the Village General Fund. The cost increase will then result in Phase 2 being executed over a number of years.

North Coast Inland Trail/Genoa/Elmore

Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2022 – Jannah Wilson reported that she met with Craig Miller who works for the Ottawa County Engineer, regarding the trail improvement along Martin Williston Rd. They agreed it would be best to separate the trail from the road if possible. He would like and is able to work with us to ensure that the road improvements

they are designing and the trail improvements we will be designing do not adversely affect each other. He will talk to Ron Lajti, Ottawa County Engineer, to determine if he could do a feasibility study for the joint projects to ensure this. We need to have the trail route options drawn up, noting proximity to the ditch and possible drainage issues relative to the trail options before we move to the next steps.

Catawba Islander Trail and Greenway - **Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2022** – Jannah Wilson reported that we had ~240 people at the Catawba Islander Trail and Greenway Open House on October 26, 2022. Lauren Falcone, PDG, is writing a report to summarize the meeting. Jannah noted that one of our next steps is to discuss the options coming out of the Master Plan with the Catawba Island Trustees, Police and EMS and ODOT before identifying a preferred route. Jannah reviewed a Fact Sheet Lauren is developing. She will send it to the board for their review and comments. Jannah noted the Public Survey closes on November 11 after which PDG will summarize the survey in a report. At the time of the meeting, 487 people had responded to the survey.

ACTION: *Jannah Wilson to determine if data delineating between first and second home could be obtained from either the Ottawa County Auditor's office or the Ottawa County Board of Elections, possibly with the auditor telling us what percent of property tax bills are sent out of the county.*

Friends of Ottawa County Parks (FoOCP) **Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2022** – Jannah Wilson reported that the Friends of Ottawa County will be meeting on November 14, 2022 at 6:00 PM. She noted that 28 people indicated they are interested in volunteering with the Friends and/or the Park District through the Catawba Islander Trail and Greenway survey. We discussed that volunteers could be managed through the Friends group or through the Park District. Jason Lewis, Director Ottawa National Wildlife Refuge, noted that for the most part, their Friends group focuses on fundraising and the Wildlife Refuge has a volunteer group that helps with events, maintenance, etc. They have a Volunteer Service Agreement with each volunteer. They provide gear for the volunteers. The board asked Jannah to ask the Prosecuting Attorney if we can fund anything, such as volunteer t-shirts, for the Friends group.

Portage River Water Trail - **Meeting Minutes for November 1, 2022** – Jannah Wilson reported that the Portage River Water Trail partners requested additional time for their organizations to review and approve or comment on the Memorandum of Understanding between the Portage River Water Trail Partners and the Park District of Ottawa County Board of Park Commissioners as facilitator. Jannah will have the formal agreement and resolution prepared for the November 15th, 2022 Park District Board meeting and will gain partner signatures following board approval. Jannah will be providing a presentation regarding the Water Trail plans at the next Portage River Basin Council meeting at 2pm on November 15th, but will not be able to get partner signatures at that time since it won't yet be board approved
