 - a. North Coast Inland Trail/Genoa/Elmore Meeting Minutes for June 20, 2023 Jannah Wilson requested the board pass Resolution 2023-17 Ratifying the Acceptance of the Transfer of the North Coast Inland Trail Property from Witty Rd. to Martin Williston Rd. which approves the transfer of the portion of the North Coast Inland trail from Witty Rd. to Martin Williston Rd from the Ottawa County Commissioners to the Park District of Ottawa County. Jannah noted that the Park District would need to request an easement from Clay Twp. for the property adjacent to Martin Williston Rd. to move the North Coast Inland Trail off Martin Williston Rd. to a separated multi-use trail adjacent to Martin Williston Rd Jannah also noted that Prosecuting Attorney James VanEerten has reviewed and approved the North Coast Inland Trail property transfer document.

b. North Coast Inland Trail/Genoa/Millbury – Meeting Minutes for June 20, 2023 – Jannah Wilson noted that Clay Twp. has indicated they currently mow adjacent to Martin Williston Rd. twice per year and when the trail is relocated to an off-road separated trail from Martin Williston Rd. they plan to mow three times per year. They also noted they will not conduct any other maintenance work on the trail. Jannah noted that the corridor along Martin Williston Rd. does not have many trees and bushes along it, so believes that tree and bush trimming will be minimal.
Harper Cromley passed out a cost estimate for the engineering, design and construction to separate the North Coast Inland Trail currently on Martin Williston Rd. to a separated multi-use trail along Martin Williston Rd. for the board's review. Harper noted that we could apply for an ODOT Systemic Safety Grant or an ODOT TAP Grant for this project. After discussion, the board agreed that we should not apply for a TAP grant for this smaller project, but an ODOT Systemic Safety grant or an ODNR Recreational Trail Grant would be more appropriate. It was noted that the ODNR Recreational Trail Grant before we

The board noted that this is a project that we could also request community support for, e.g. possible material donation from a local quarry, monetary donations from local businesses. The board also noted the Friends of Ottawa County Parks could also help obtain donations.

Harper noted that the survey of Martin Williston Rd. and the trail corridor was conducted by the county, but noted the survey increments are larger than what Kleinfelder would use, so Kleinfelder will conduct additional survey work that meets their standards.

ACTION: *Jannah Wilson/Harper Cromley to determine the application timing requirement for the ODNR Recreational Trail Grant relative to starting work on the project.

c. Catawba Islander Trail and Greenway — **Meeting Minutes for June 20, 2023** — Jannah Wilson requested the board pass Resolution 2023-19 Proposal and Contract, Natural Heritage LLC, giving Jannah authority to sign the proposal and contract with Natural Heritage LLC for Clean Ohio Grant Writing and Management Coordination. Jannah noted she will perform as much of the work as possible, e.g. she will conduct the plant survey, but it will be helpful to have the leadership and guidance of Natural Heritage LLC who has experience writing Clean Ohio grants since this is the first time we are applying for a Clean Ohio Grant. Noting the cost of the contract and the hourly rate, Trish McCartney asked if 154 hours was a typical length of time to complete a grant application. Jannah noted this time included an environmental survey, an endangered species survey as well as the actual grant writing, so it was believed to be reasonable. Jack Madison noted that we should contact Kim Kaufman, Executive Director of Black Swamp Bird Observatory, soon, to help conduct the endangered bird survey as well as Matt Montowski, Catawba Island Twp. Trustee, to obtain the name of the person who has conducted bat surveys. Jannah agreed with both. Identifying any endangered species in the area will add points to our

grant. Likewise, we are required to provide a 25% match, but will receive additional points for a higher % match. September 8, 2023 is the deadline for the application.

 Jannah and the board discussed what process we should use to select a consultant for the Marblehead Peninsula Trail Feasibility Study. It was agreed we would use a scoring sheet to evaluate the RFPs. Linda Amos noted she previously provided a sample scoring sheet for contractor selection to the Park District. Jannah will attempt to locate the score sheet. Jannah will also request other local Park District Executive Directors to help in our selection process. It was noted that we do

h. Denny noted they are asked to provide volunteers to support the festival and the Friends will also need volunteers to support the Friends' information booth. Denny noted they continue to work on updating their brochure. A discussion was held regarding their logo which currently is the logo from the Ottawa County Active Transportation Plan. He noted this logo is too busy to be printed on items such as hats. Linda Amos is attempting to obtain the original high resolution digital file for the logo. Jannah noted that a number of Park Districts and their corresponding Friends group have similar, but slightly different logos to indicate separate, but related organizations. Jannah will contact the person who created the Park District of Ottawa County logo to determine if he could help with creation of a Friends' logo. It was noted that it would be advantageous to ensure that the logos make it clear that the Park District of Ottawa County and the Friends of Ottawa County Park are separate organizations but work together.
